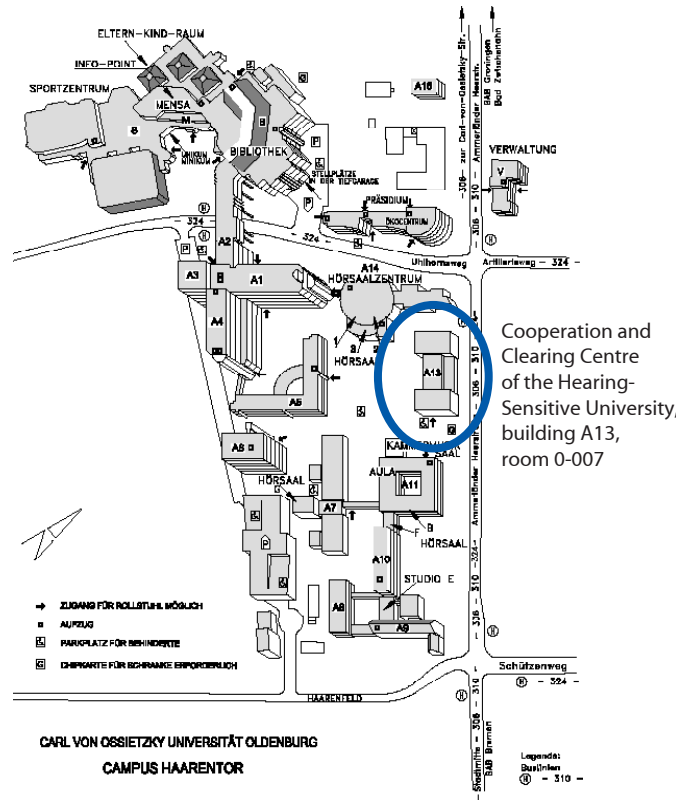

TARGETGROUP

An increasing amount of young adults suffers from mild to moderate hearing impairments, i.e. is in need of hearing aids or cochlea implants or suffers from tinnitus. People with hearing impairments often face serious limitations regarding speech comprehension, acoustic perception, concentration and social interaction.



A good acoustic environment in schools and universities is crucial for students with a hearing impairment to be able to fully participate in the transfer of knowledge.

The Cooperation and Clearing Centre by the 'Hörsensible Universität Oldenburg' committee caters to students and university staff. Children and young adults with mild to moderate hearing impairments and their families as well as prospective students are more than welcome.
